




Since 1877 Dexter Avenue King Memorial Baptist Church has been a symbol of respect, blessings and service. There has been a constant challenge to accommodate tourism and Church activities, and this 6,330 square foot addition by architects Goodwyn,

Mills & Cawood, along with Russell Construction, will be the first expansion since its initial construction. The building will include space for administrative and educational requirements, contributing to the growth and enhancement of the Legacy. The congregation will use the Church solely for Sunday worship, weddings, funerals, lectures, and revivals as well as a dedicated tour site. Once the new building is completed, the Dexter Avenue King Memorial Foundation will oversee the tour program at the Church during the week. Completion is scheduled for December, 2008.

This expansion comes at a significant point in Dexter's rich history: The Church is one of 14 U.S. sites to be considered for nomination to the UNESCO (United Nations Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization) World Heritage List, recognizing the most significant cultural and national treasures on Earth.
